

Cookies Policy

Background

This Policy applies as between you, the User of this Website and Khwezi Trade, the owner and provider of this Website.

1. Definitions and Interpretation

In this Policy the following terms shall have the following meanings:

“Data” means collectively all information that you submit to the Khwezi Trade via the Website. This definition shall, where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the Data Protection Act 1998;

“Cookie” means a small text file placed on your computer by this Website when you visit certain parts of the Website and/or when you use certain features of the Website. Details of the cookies used by this Website are set out in Clause 12;

“UK and EU Cookie Law” means the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 as amended by the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) (Amendment) Regulations 2011;

“User” means any third party that accesses the Website and is not employed by Khwezi Trade and acting in the course of their employment; and

“Website” means the website that you are currently using (www.khwezitrade.co.za) and any sub-domains of this site (e.g. www.subdomain.khwezitrade.co.za) unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions.

2. Scope of This Policy

This Policy applies only to the actions of Khwezi Trade and Users with respect to this Website. It does not extend to any websites that can be accessed from this Website including, but not limited to, any links we may provide to social media websites.

3. Cookies

Cookies are snippets of code placed on your computer to help us deliver our service we offer, measure marketing or analyse the performance of our Website.

3.1 This Website may place and access certain first party Cookies on your computer. First party cookies are those placed directly by Khwezi Trade via this Website and are used only by us. We use Cookies to improve your experience of using the Website and to improve our range of services. We have carefully chosen these Cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy is always protected and respected.

3.2 By using this Website you may receive certain third-party Cookies on your computer. Third party cookies are those placed by websites and/or parties other than Khwezi Trade. Third party cookies are used on this Website for marketing and analytical purposes and are detailed in full below.

3.3 All Cookies used by this Website are used in accordance with current UK and EU Cookie Law.

3.4 Certain features of the Website depend upon Cookies to function. UK and EU Cookie Law deems these Cookies to be “strictly necessary”. These Cookies are shown below. Your consent will not be sought to place these Cookies. You may still block these cookies by changing your internet browser’s settings as detailed below.
